

Now available: New, faster way to request NACC data

NACC is introducing a new and even faster way to request and receive NACC data: The **Quick-access Full Data File**. The file contains [UDS](#), [NP](#), and [APOE](#) data on all UDS participants and all visits, based on the most recently quarterly data archive.

(Of course, you can still request a custom data file, tailored to your research question. NACC staff are available to help you navigate the nuances of the data.)

To get the new Quick-access Full Data File, just submit your data request as usual. **You will receive an email from NACC asking whether you prefer a Quick-access data file or a custom one.** After signing NACC's data use agreement, you will be directed to a secure site where you can download your file.
